## Queer Xangjug – In-Person Residential Workshop (Phase 1)

• **4th & 7th October 2025 | Ayang–Okum, Majuli**

The residential workshop under Queer Xangjug 2.0 focused on social action, leadership building and collective visioning.

**Across four days, 22nd participants engaged in sessions including:**

- **Reading together and understanding feminist writing in academia**
- **Reflection sessions and performed conversations**
- **Theatre for team building**
- **Design thinking, vision building and developing possible solutions**
- **Understanding campaigns and social action planning**

The workshop created a reflective, participatory and collaborative learning environment rooted in feminist and queer politics.



# Swabhiman

- **9th November 2025 | Sivasagar, Assam**

In collaboration with the District Legal Services Authority, this session engaged 26 police personnel, focusing on transgender rights, legal provisions and inclusive law enforcement practices.



- **6th December 2025 | Golaghat, Assam**

Jointly organised with the District Legal Services Authority, the program engaged 48 participants from law enforcement and social welfare departments, strengthening understanding of rights-based and gender-sensitive approaches.



- **10th December 2025 | Morigaon, Assam**

Jointly organised with the District Legal Services Authority, this workshop brought together 25 stakeholders and community members to discuss implementation gaps, access to justice and institutional responsibilities.
