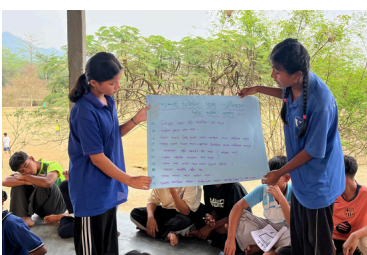
- Two-Day Event on **“Unmasking Identities”** at Royal Global University, Guwahati on **5th & 6th March (Over 100 Participants)**
